3. The topics for the competition are:

c. **CAG@2047: Imagine you are the CAG of India in year 2047. What will be your strategy for the institution?**

Participants may write on any one of the topics in either English or Hindi. The maximum word limit is **1500 words**. Essays are to be submitted by e-mail at **essay2022@cag.gov.in** between **1000 hrs on 16th August 2022 to 1700 hrs on 15th September 2022**.


4. Students under the age of **25 years** as on 15 August 2022, enrolled in a course of study at an institution recognised by any University in India shall be eligible for participating in the competition.
